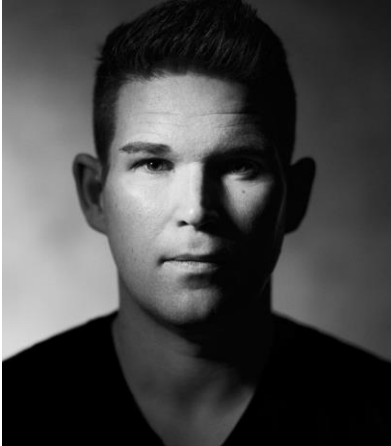


Dunk Tank Nominees 2023

HSC Chief Operating Officer

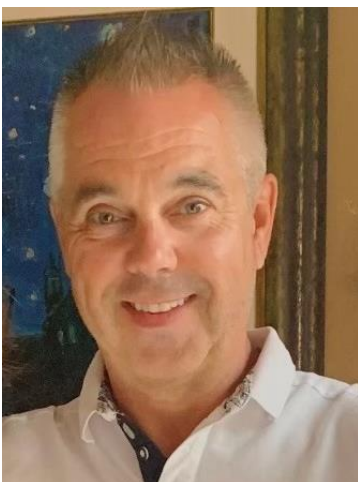
