Dr. Perry Gray's career spans more than 20 years at the Health Sciences Centre. Dr. Gray trained as a general surgeon in Winnipeg; adding a 2nd specialty in critical care medicine that included a research year in the United Kingdom. In the 1990's, Dr. Gray's clinical practice spanned trauma/acute care surgery, critical care and intravenous nutrition. He was the Medical Director of the Trauma Service, the Surgical Intensive Care Unit and the Deputy Chief of Surgery.

In 2000, Dr. Gray ceased his operative practice as a general surgeon and was appointed Chief Medical Officer in 2001, a position he held until he retired in 2024. Dr. Gray continues to provide direct patient care as a Critical Care Physician.

Dr. Gray believes that the way to make the correct decision in health care is to view the issue through the eyes of the patient. He is committed to HSC's vision of "Patients First".

Dr. Gray has been directly involved in many infrastructure developments and new patient services enhancing patient care at the Health Sciences Centre.
